

# Life Stages - Activities Guide

## LIFE STAGES



### 1. Can students put life stages in order?

- Initially give students 3-4 images and ask them to place them in order of youngest to oldest. (These can be photos of friends/family or ones provided)
- Randomise the photos being shown.
- Once students have displayed confidence with 3-4, try providing them photos of all ages.

### 2. Can students label and describe each life stage?

- Ask student to name each life stage. (Baby, toddler etc).
- This could be done verbally, using visuals or using written cards.
- Next ask students to describe each of the photos.
  - What does this person look like?
  - How old is this person?
  - What sorts of things do they like and do?

### 3. Does the student know what stage they are in?

- Ask the student to show you which stage they are in. This can be done by them placing their own picture on top, by pointing or by verbalising.
- Next ask them to tell you who they know that is in each of the stages.
- Finally, ask them what stage they will be in next.
